If you only want your trees delivered that can also be arranged for a smaller fee.

**Large B&B Shade Trees:** 2 ½ -5" diameter trunk, trees up to 20' tall; **Maples:** Autumn Blaze, Emerald Lustre, Norway, Sugar, Deborah (or similar), Crimson King, & Royal Red (dark reddish/purple leaves all season); **Oaks;** **Birch:** Whitespire & River Birch-1-4 stems & up to 16' tall; **Linden:** Greenspire & Little Leaf; **Others:** Elm; Honey Locust; & more.

**Potted Shade Trees:** Autumn Blaze 8-10' & 6-7' Crimson Kings 5-6', Newport Plum (purple leaf) 6-8', Flowering Pear - Cleveland Select 6-8'

**Ornamental Trees:** Japanese Tree Lilac (8-12'); Flowering Pear (beautiful large trees up to 4" trunk & 15' tall); Flowering Crabs. Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry clump & tree form.

**Fruit Trees & Plants:** Nice Large potted fruit trees up to 1 ¼" trunk & 8' tall. **Apple:** Honeycrisp, Liberty (great disease resistance, perfect for homeowner); **Pear:** Luscious, Summercrisp; **Cherry:** Lapins, Bali; **Peach:** Frost (Leaf-curl resistant), Contender (Frost resistant, excellent taste & quality); **Strawberry:** Ft. Laramie (ever bearing), Honeoye; **Other:** Asparagus roots, Rhubarb plants

**Evergreen Trees:** (Potted Trees & B&B Trees)—Norway Spruce (2' potted trees); 3-4' and 5-6' Black Hills Spruce; Norway Spruce (Large trees from 6'-12' tall); Blue Spruce (#1's and #2's from 5-9' tall); Emerald Green Arborvitae (4-5' and 5-6'—Nice looking trees that make a great privacy border in a more confined area); American Arborvitae (4-6' & 10-12'—native to Wisconsin and make great privacy borders); Woodward Globe Arbs (4-5'); Globe Blue Spruce on a Standard

**Perennials:** (Most Perennials are in #1 containers): May Night Salvia; Pink Bleeding Hearts; White Bleeding Hearts Creeping Phlox; Purple and Orange/Red Coral Bells; Pulmonaria, Stella D' Oro Daylilies (Re-peat Bloomers); Various other Daylilies; Hostas including First Frost, Lady's Mantle; Cone flowers; Rudbeckia Black-Eyed Susan; Columbine; Kansas Peonies; Balloon Flower; Tall Garden Phlox (pink and purple); Yellow Yarrow; Siberian Iris; Ligularia; Lavender; & many more.

**Shrubs:** Compact Burning Bush; Lilacs: Dwarf Korean, Miss Kim Dwarf, French Lilacs (Dark Purple, White, & others), Golden & Flame Spirea, Green Velvet & Green Mountain Boxwood; Ninebark; Center Glow (beautiful maroon/gold foliage), Little Devil (dwarf), & Diablo. Weigela: Carnival, French Lace, Dark Horse; Hydrangea: Annabelle & PG. Roses: Yellow & Red Double Knockout, Various other shrub roses. Flowering Peonies, Flowering Forsythia & more.
